1. Scroll down and select '**Germantown Community Library**' OR '**Monarch Library System**'
2. Type in your library card number without spaces
(It is the number under the barcode on the back of your library card.)
3. Type in your pin number
(It is usually the last 4 digits of your phone number. If you have problems you can contact your library for assistance.)
4. Click '**SIGN IN**'

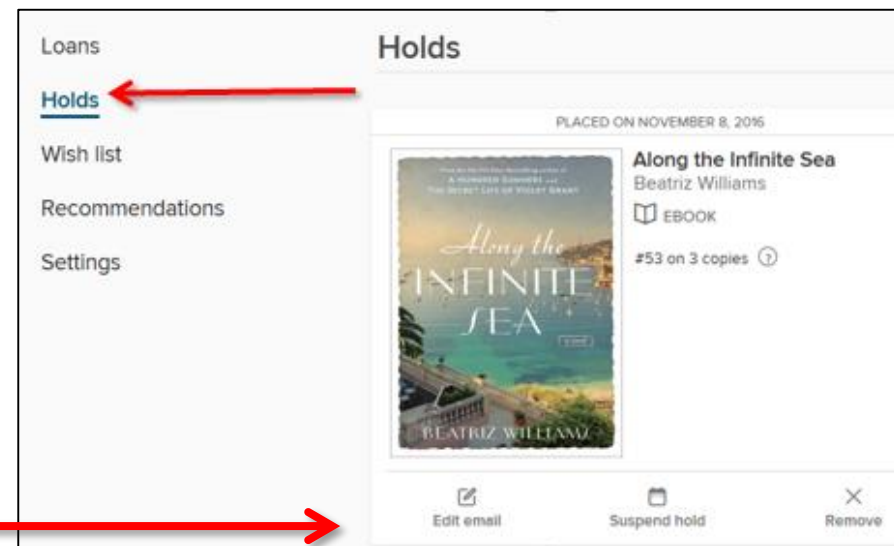
Once you check out the book, you can click on the “Read Now” button to take you to your item. You can view options for the items you check out under your account loans page.

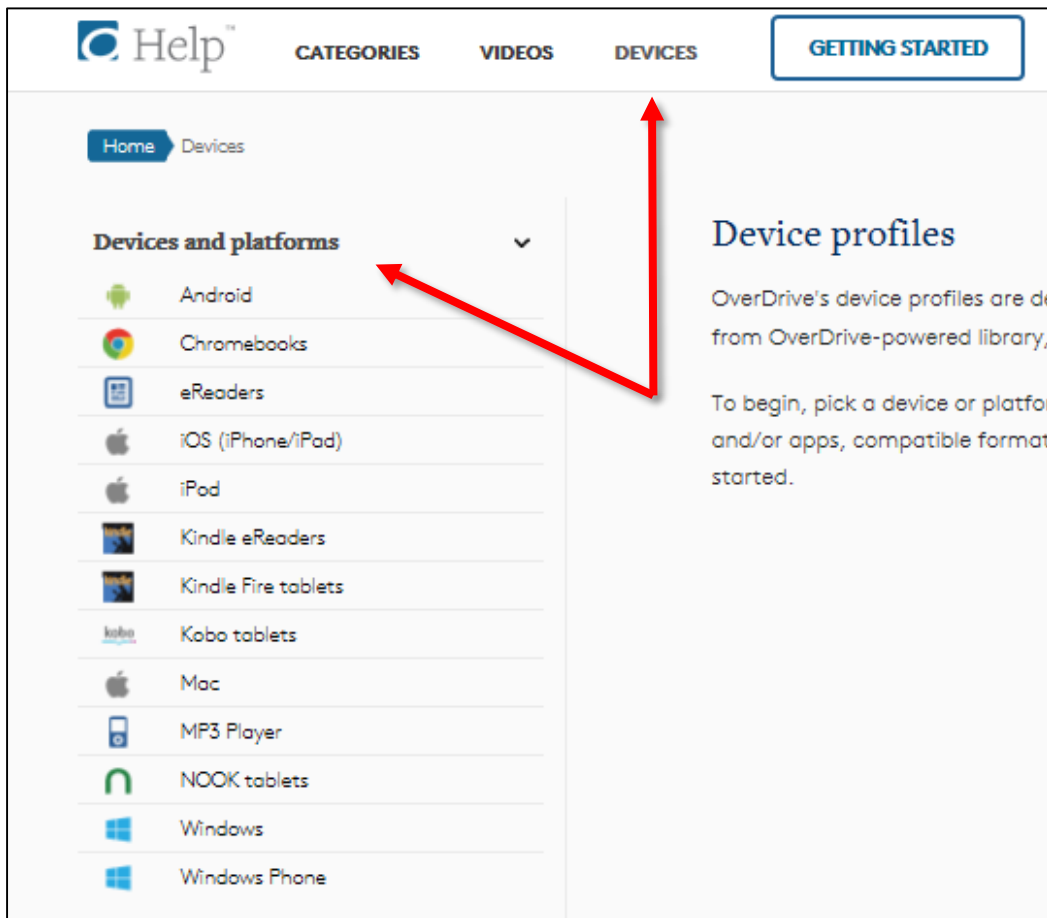
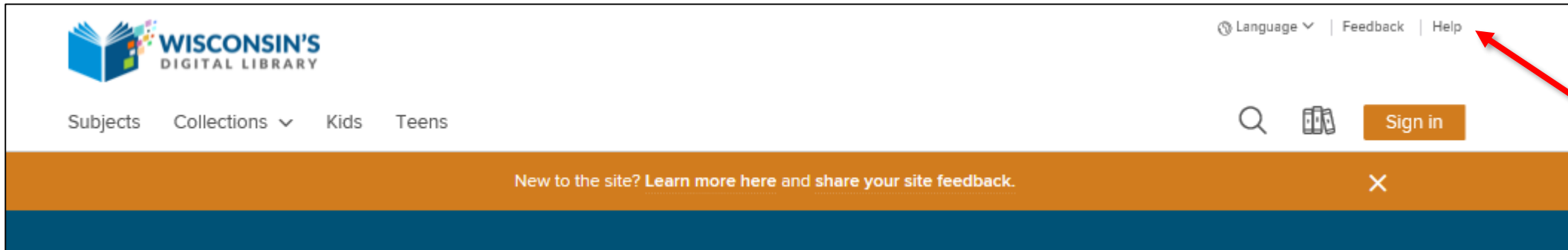


If the title is not available, click on
