Kids 0 through 6th grade receive prizes for reading and completing activities and can sign-up at the Youth Services Desk. Students 7th through 12th grade and adults receive a raffle for every book read or audiobook listened to. A drawing to win a variety of prizes and gift certificates from local businesses and restaurants will take place at the end of the program. The last day to turn in reading logs is Saturday, September 1.

The Summer Reading Program aims to promote literacy, personal growth, and life-long learning for patrons of all ages in the community.
