

RECIPE FOR A TEACUP GARDEN

Step 1: Decorate your cup with stickers.

Step 2: Place the charcoal in the bottom of the cup.

Step 3: Add the soil to the cup. Do not mix the charcoal and the soil. Push the soil toward the sides of the teacup with a "hole" in the middle.

Step 4: "Tickle the roots" of the plant(s) a bit and gently press the soil around the roots in the cup.

Step 6: Place bits of slate, rocks, or glass beads on top of the soil.

Step 7: Embellish the garden with decorations (included, or use your own).

Step 8: Water the teacup garden carefully with a spoon or two of water around the plants. No water on the plants!

Enjoy your teacup garden! Put it in a bright spot, but not in direct sun. Water your garden only once a week at most! If the soil feels damp, do not water! Use the same spoon for watering each time.
