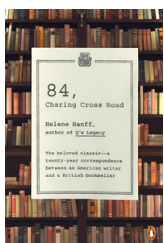

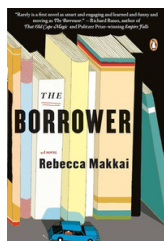

A librarian is pulled into a runaway boy's plan to escape censorship, sparking an unexpected journey of reflection.



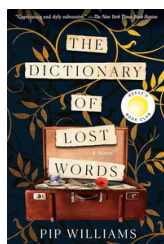
Mr. Penumbra's 24-Hour Bookshop

A quirky San Francisco bookstore hides a centuries-old secret in this clever tale of mystery and technology.



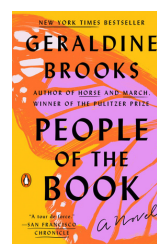
The Book of Lost Names

A rare-book expert uncovers centuries of secrets hidden in a treasured manuscript rescued from war-torn Sarajevo.



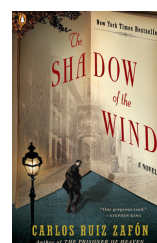
The Book Thief

A grieving bookstore owner finds healing and unexpected connections through the support of her loyal customers and books.



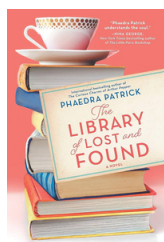
The Shadow of the Wind

A grieving bookseller uncovers a mysterious portrait that leads him into a literary quest across centuries.



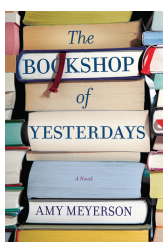
The Library of Lost and Found

A hidden book leads a graduate student to a secret underground world of stories, symbols, and timeless love.



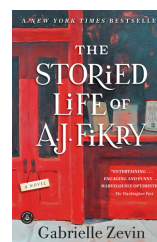
The Bookshop of Yesterdays
